

## **HOC Volunteer Opportunities**

### **Patient Facing Volunteer Roles**

*Patient Facing volunteers have the most direct interaction with patients and families. Orientation class, Health and Background Screening, Vaccinations (COVID, Flu, MMR, Varicella and a TB test) are required. The service commitment is a minimum of two hours per week for 1 year. All roles serve without monetary compensation.*

- Vigil/Bedside Presence**- supporting patients alone and/or actively dying
- Home Care** – provides friendship and respite care in patient home.
- Long term Care** – provides friendship and activities within a nursing facility.
- Housekeeping/Errands** – light housework, pet care and errands for patients.
- Concierge** – hospitality, companionship & operations in IPCC
- Screeener/Greeter** – welcomes and provides hospitality to visitors of IPCC.
- Art Activities** – patient art visits as directed by the Art Coordinator.
- Cosmetologist** - cosmetology services to patients. License required
- Massage/Healing Touch/Reiki** – provides healing arts. License required.
- Music Activities** – performs music for patients under direction Music Therapist.
- Veteran to Veteran** – companionship and recognition of veteran patients.
- Spiritual Care and Eucharistic Minister** – provides spiritual support consistent with the patient’s values and faith traditions under direction of Chaplain
- Pet Therapy** – Visits with a certified therapy animal. License required.

### **Administrative Support**

*Administrative support volunteers have less patient contact. The onboarding requirements and service are the same as for Patient Facing Volunteers listed above.*

- Clerical** – Data Entry, filing, phone calls, mailings etc.
- Flowers** – Transporting, arranging and delivering flowers in the IPCC.
- Maintenance/Gardening** – filling bird feeders, weeding, planting, etc.

### **Community Service**

*Community Service volunteers have minimal patient contact and perform most of their service offsite. Requirements include application and role specific orientation.*

- Crafting/Sewing** - volunteers make and donates items in need.
- Forget Me Not** – assemble care packages for patients, caregivers or staff.
- Fundraising** – donor thank you calls, event preparation or committee service.
- Board and Committee** – serving in a leadership role (invitation only)
- Baking and Meals** – provide baked goods or holiday meal for our IPCC.
- Speakers Bureau** – support speaking presentations to the community
- Ambassador** – represent HOC at community events and fairs.
